COMPLAINT

There is no other pending or resolved civil action arising out of the transaction or occurrence alleged in this complaint.

INTRODUCTION

This matter involves a municipal government and their duly elected City Council members using personal email address accounts to conduct the affairs of the government and shielding such public records from the public eye. Such mechanism erects a roadblock for citizens who utilizes the Michigan Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA") and prevents them

from the ability to truthfully obtain full and complete information about the affairs of the government and the official acts of those who represent them as public officials. The plaintiff, Charles Blackwell, is a local open government advocate who routinely uses the Freedom of Information Act to obtain relevant documents from state and local governments across Metro Detroit to promote accountability and transparency in government.

Dearborn Heights Mayor Daniel Paletko and the City Council has been in a contentious legal battle and power struggle since February of 2019 when a reported \$1.4 million became missing from the city's Public, Educational, and Government programming fees, or PEG fund. The City Council has wanted to hire an independent law firm to conduct a forensic audit of that PEG fund to search for any irregularities. The Mayor has obstructed attempts by City Council to hire a law firm by refusing to sign the retainer agreement and failing to abide by subpoena's issued by the City Council.

Plaintiff filed a FOIA request on September 19th, 2020 with the City of Dearborn Heights to obtain emails from Defendant and chairwoman Denise Malinowksi-Maxwell regarding the important and contentious topics of Dearborn Heights Corporation Counsel Gary Miotke, Mayor Daniel Paletko, and the PEG audit issue. Despite requesting emails sent and received of an almost two-week timeframe between September 1st and September 15th of important Dearborn Heights political topics, chairwoman Malinowksi-Maxwell only provided one email to the plaintiff from her personal email account address. However, additional emails provided voluntarily by Mayor Daniel Paletko shows additional emails which would be responsive to the plaintiff FOIA request being sent and received from Malinowksi-Maxwell personal email account during the requested time period. The emails provided by the Mayor contradicts and

shows Malinowski-Maxwell has not provided all responsive emails to the plaintiff and is intentionally concealing additional emails from the plaintiff which are public records. Plaintiff has pleaded with the Defendant through their Mayor and full City Council to simply comply with the FOIA act and reminded them such judicial action to have to compel further wrongfully withheld emails would unfairly cause taxpayers money and waste judicial resources. THE PARTIES

- 1. Plaintiff, Charles Blackwell ("Blackwell") is a resident of Wayne County, Michigan.
- 2. Plaintiff is a lawful "person" as defined in the ("FOIA") law pursuant to MCL 15.232(g) and has the right to obtain documents under the Michigan Freedom of Information Act.
- 3. Defendant, the City of Dearborn Heights ("Dearborn Heights"), is a municipality located in Wayne County, Michigan and therefore is a public body within the meaning of MCL 15.232(h)(iii).
- 4. Defendant, Denise Malinowski-Maxwell ("Malinowski-Maxwell"), is a duly elected City Council member for the City of Dearborn Heights and resident of Dearborn Heights.
- 5. Defendant Malinowski-Maxwell is sued in her official capacity as an elected City Council member and the chair of the City Council.

JURISDICTION

- 6. Venue is proper pursuant to MCL 15.240(1)(b).
- 7. Since the defendant City of Dearborn Heights is in Wayne County, venue is appropriate in Wayne County Circuit Court.

8. This action should be assigned for hearing and trial or for argument at the earliest practicable date and expedited in every way. (See generally MCL 15.240(5)).

STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 9. Denise Malinowski-Maxwell is the chairwoman of the City Council for the City of Dearborn Heights.
- 10. Malinowski-Maxwell does not have nor uses a municipal provided email address to conduct public policy or the affairs of the Defendant.
- 11. Denise Malinowski-Maxwell has listed a personal email address "denisemalinowskimaxwell@gmail.com" on the Defendant website in which she utilizes for government business and affairs.
- 12. Emails whether used from a municipal or personal email address account is considered a public record as long as it is "a writing prepared, owned, used, in the possession of, or retained by a public body in the performance of an official function, from the time it is created."
- 13. Gary Miotke was appointed to the position of Corporation Counsel by Mayor Daniel Paletko.
- 14. At the September 8th, 2020 City Council meeting the City Council passed *resolution 20-312* by a 4-3 vote in which the resolution called for Dearborn Heights Mayor Paletko to cooperate with council members or be investigated for misconduct and removed from office over

his handling of the longstanding financial audit involving the Public, Educational, and Government programming fees, or PEG fund.

- 15. Chairwoman Malinowksi-Maxwell also contended during this meeting that Gary Miotke has not legally been the city's attorney for months and that he is "impersonating an appointed official" since he wasn't reappointed after his contract ended approximately in April of 2020.
- 16. On September 19th, 2020 the plaintiff emailed and faxed a FOIA request to the Defendant, City of Dearborn Heights, on September 19th, 2020 essentially seeking all emails sent and received by chairwoman Malinowski-Maxwell between the time frame of September 1st, 2020 to September 15th, 2020 regarding the topics of Corporation Counsel Gary Miotke, Mayor Daniel Paletko, or the PEG audit issue. (See Attached Exhibit B: Original FOIA Request)
- 17. On September 29th, 2020 FOIA Coordinator Kristina Laslo provided to the Plaintiff only one email that she said was provided by chairwoman Malinowski-Maxwell in response to the plaintiff FOIA request. This was a September 9th, 2020 email sent by Mayor Daniel Paletko to chairwoman Malinowski-Maxwell and other City Council members. (See Attached Exhibit C: Email Provided by Malinowski-Maxwell).
- 18. On September 30th, 2020 FOIA Coordinator Kristina Laslo provided two voluntarily emails from Mayor Daniel Paletko municipal email address account to the Plaintiff in which it shows Councilwoman Malinowski-Maxwell sending an lengthy email to Gary Miotke on September 8th discussing his status as Corporation Council, contract for his law firm services

and interpretation of the City Charter. These emails were not subject to a FOIA request.

(Attached Exhibit C: Emails Provided by Mayor Paletko).

- 19. The emails provided by FOIA Coordinator Kristina Laslo from Mayor Paletko municipal email account directly contradicts Councilwoman Malinowski-Maxwell assertions that she only possesses one email that is responsive to the Plaintiff FOIA request.
- Chairwoman Malinowski-Maxwell only produced to the plaintiff a September 9th, 2020 20. email that she received from Mayor Paletko. However, emails provided by Mayor Paletko shows Malinowksi-Maxwell sending an email to Gary Miotke on September 8th, 2020. Which means Councilwoman Malinowksi-Maxwell has not been truthful and produced all emails from her personal email address account that are responsive to the Plaintiff FOIA request.

COUNT 1

CLAIM FOR VIOLATION OF FOIA (MCL 15.231 et. seq)

- 21. Plaintiff incorporates herein by reference each of the preceding paragraphs.
- 22. Plaintiff September 19th, 2020 request to the City of Dearborn Heights constituted a "written request" within the meaning of MCL 15.232(m)
- 23. The records requested by the Plaintiff are a part of the "public record" under MCL 15.232(i) because the emails from Councilwoman Malinowski-Maxwell personal email address is owned and used in the performance of her official role and function as a City Council member.
- 24. The Defendant's, City of Dearborn Heights and Denise Malinowski-Maxwell has failed to produce all the requested email responsive to his September 19th FOIA request.

- 25. Upon the belief and knowledge of the Plaintiff, the Defendant's by City of Dearborn Heights and through Councilwoman Denise Malinowski-Maxwell, has other emails in their possession which are public records that are responsive the Plaintiff request in which they are either concealing, hiding, or have deleted in violation of the FOIA act.
- 26. Because this suit was necessary to compel Defendant's disclosure of the requested public records, Plaintiff is entitled to "reasonable fees, costs, and disbursements", pursuant to MCL 15.240(6).
- 27. Defendant's has arbitrarily and capriciously violated the FOIA act by intentionally concealing and failing to produce emails responsive to the Plaintiff FOIA request. As such, Plaintiff is entitled to punitive damages of \$1,000 in addition to actual and compensatory damages pursuant to MCL 15.240(7).
- 28. Defendant has willfully and intentionally failed to comply with the ("FOIA") law and therefore should be subject to a civil fine of between \$2,500 and \$7,500 as allowed under MCL 15.240b

RELIEF SOUGHT

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff, Charles Blackwell, respectfully requests this

Honorable Court to enter a judgment against Defendant, City of Dearborn Heights, ordering:

A. Assign this action for hearing at the earliest practicable date and expedite it in every way in accordance with MCL 15.240(5).

B. Schedule an In-Camera Review of all of Defendant Malinowski-Maxwell emails from between September 1st to September 15th to ensure all responsive emails are produced.

C. An order that the defendant arbitrarily and capriciously violated the Freedom of Information Act by concealing emails, and awarding Plaintiff \$1,000 in punitive damages for Defendant's failure to comply with the Freedom of Information Act, plus costs, and disbursements in this action as provided by law.

D. Assess the Defendant a civil fine of between \$2,500 and \$7,500 for failure to comply with the act under MCL 15.240b E. That such additional relief be granted to the Plaintiff as may be deemed just and proper

Dear Council Members:

I think that we can all agree that last night's meeting was a horrible example of working together. We need to have some sort of communication outside of letters drafted by attorneys and figure out an end-game. If the goal is to go over every invoice/record for every department for the last five years, then a compromise will not happen. However, if the City Council can articulate what it is that the collective body is looking for, then, as I have continually stated, I can provide those records to you.

I am vehement about having some sort of city control over this process and giving all powers to your attorney and his accountant has serious potential of a financial black hole with dollars that the city cannot afford. Your body needs to have continued study sessions to accept the documents requested and deliberate on the cost-benefit analysis of each fund that you are investigating.

I can assure you that there is no "missing money" or malfeasance, however, the majority of you simply will not listen to me. Therefore, you need to ask yourself what you think my administration has failed to do and what you will find. For example, if you believe that PEG funds were used to pay for salaries in the cable department, then you are right! I have budgeted those salaries in the cable department against PEG fees and your body has approved the budget each year. Records will only show this. Subsequently, the auditors have audited this and have even included it in their report long before I became mayor. In addition, if you feel that some employee is getting extra compensation over what was approved by council, then please ask for that employee's records. Throwing a net to capture all employees, using other employees' time to copy and redact records and then paying both your attorney and accountant to review these documents when you are only concerned about a handful of employees is not fiscally responsible. I hope that your body will soon have a study session and take my suggestions seriously to speed up this process and finally put it to rest.

When deliberating over the city attorney, your body can throw this right back to me by simply voting yes or no to Gary Miotke's appointment. "Assumptions" have no place in city government when a simple vote of your body can "move this along". Upon your vote, I will act accordingly by either continuing Gary's tenure as Corporation Counsel or submitting another name to your body. I must state that I still maintain my powers as outlined in the Charter and will not create a contract with Gary or any other firm. It is in my powers that the city attorney serves and I retain the right to remove the city attorney and/or approve assistant corporation counsels.

Thank you for the information Mr. Miotke. This helps identify what we have been paying to your firm while you served as Corporation Counsel. Your statement that there is no term is irrelevant to your status as our former Corporation Counsel. The Charter clearly indicates that there is no holdover status. You may also want to review Section 20-33(b) of the City Code.

Further, while your email references that it would apply to Assistant Corporation Counsels, the underlying engagements are not referenced. Nor is the list of firms supposedly covered by such an engagement. Even more to the point, and pursuant to the Charter, Assistant Corporation Counsels are "appointed" by Corporation Counsel subject to the Mayor's approval and subject to compensation levels set by the Council. Appointment is different than "retaining" the services of

outside counsel by contract such as the language utilized in section 5.13(j). That also requires that there be a specific term and duration for such engagements.

Please see the attached Motion #19-067 and the back-up for same. This motion was adopted on February 26, 2019. It approved my request for an increase in the "compensation for Corporation Counsel and all firms acting as Assistant Corporation Counsels." It increased the hourly compensation by \$5.00 per hour and was the first increase in compensation since 2015.
